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
VCICDP: Key Features

Expand industrial output

Increase manufacturing sector's contribution to GDP and boost exports (Increase of manufacturing share from 9.4% to 20% in Andhra Pradesh by 2045)

Expand employment opportunities

Increase employment opportunities in the formal sector (Generation of about 9.5 million jobs by 2045)

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Impact, Outcome and Outputs (1/2)

- Impact: Increased contribution of the manufacturing sector to the state's GDP, trade, and employment
- Outcome: Enhanced growth and competitiveness of the VCIC
- Outputs:
 - ✓ Output 1: Corridor management strengthened and ease of doing business improved (supported by Policy-based Loan and CDTA)
 - Capacity development of institutions engaged in corridor management;
 - Support to enhance ease of doing business including establishment of an e-portal a single-desk system, with incentives for women entrepreneurs;
 - Industrial and sector policies to stimulate industrial development;
 and
 - Improvement in investor promotion, trade facilitation and logistics

Impact, Outcome and Outputs (2/2)

- ✓ Output 2: VCIC infrastructure strengthened and more resilient (supported by MFF (Project Loans) and UCCRTF Grant)
 - Internal roads, water supply, drainage, and industrial effluent treatment in selected industrial clusters;
 - Roads for connectivity between industrial nodes, ports, and urban areas, and road safety measures;
 - Power transmission and distribution system in the industrial corridor; and
 - Smart cities planning with climate change resilience and continuous water supply in Visakhapatnam, the key city in the VCIC
- ✓ Output 3: Institutional capacities, human resources, and program management strengthened
 - Skills enhancement of workers and entrepreneurs, especially women;


