#### STF and Road Safety

- Still a substantial issue for GMS countries

#### **COVID-19 and Road Safety**



- Pandemic has been equally risky as road safety
- Both can be avoided by improving human behavior
- Global actions to avoid COVID more than TWO years old
- Road safety actions take more than THREE decades
- Key anti-COVID actions: self-education-enforcement
- Self-education-enforcement doable for road safety!
- Anti-COVID actions are not cost-free
- Road safety can be cost-free: be safe, avoid risks,
   be an advocate, be an enforcer, make others safe
