# STF and Road Safety



- **STF initiated road safety since 2011**
- **Since then STF discussed road safety yearly**
- **Still a substantial issue for GMS countries**
- **Now we have road safety with COVID...**
- **Sharing knowledge among GMS is important**
- **Long term engagement necessary for success**
- **STF will continue to support road safety actions**

# COVID-19 and Road Safety



- Pandemic has been equally risky as road safety
- Both can be avoided by improving human behavior
- Global actions to avoid COVID more than TWO years old
- Road safety actions take more than THREE decades
- Key anti-COVID actions: self-education-enforcement
- Self-education-enforcement doable for road safety!
- Anti-COVID actions are not cost-free
- Road safety can be cost-free: **be safe, avoid risks, be an advocate, be an enforcer, make others safe**
